Upcoming work on 9<sup>th</sup> St. Bridge over I-94 will put an epoxy surface this Friday. Starting Monday, I-94 BL at Kings HWY and M-96 to Michigan Ave project is expected to begin.

Johnson noted projects were delayed due to the weather. Road Commission has 220 projects and \$13 million in projects this season. Please be patient.
